Other Items to Know and Consider

Header and Footer

- The header and footer will be the same across all microsites and will be managed by the Global Admin(s). Content in the body of the page (between the header and footer) will be managed by the microsite Super Admins.
- Each microsite name should be less than 20 characters to display properly.

Admins

- You can have multiple Global Admins, and there has to be at least one Global Admin. There can also be multiple Super Admins and Admins assigned to a microsite.
- Every Admin and Super Admin is only associated with one microsite. This applies to where their opportunities are posted and which reports they can pull.
 - Example: Jane Doe can be the Super Admin for the Microsite A, but she can't be the Super Admin for both Microsite A and Microsite B.
 - An Admin in one microsite *can* be made a Co-Admin for an opportunity created on anothermicrosite.
- The Global Admin can see everything, edit everything, and pull reports on everything.
- All Super admins and the Global Admins can see and manage users.
- All content in the *Configure System* section of the Administration tab is managed by the Global Admin(s). The settings in this section affect the whole site, making it important for all Super Admins to agree on how to set up categories, award cycles, and the Participating Organization Hierarchy (school/college/dept list).
